The programme

Programme dates: 22nd June – 31st July 2026

Transfers from Manchester airport to Bradford included.

Class schedule: 16 hours of English language tuition (Monday to Friday) in English for Academic Purposes (EAP) plus a trip to a local place of interest or social activity each week, for 6 weeks. All teaching materials are provided.
